Goals

- Improve Consistency & Standards
- Simplify the options for the user
- Allow user to more easily navigate the sport pages
- Structure the navigation to have consistent structure and styles
- Provide user with more visual assistance or text help so they are aware of the menu's functionality and how to access all pages

Requirements

- Allow access to all of the pages the specific sport has to offer, provide ability to switch to these different pages for clients with this navigation
- Page title styles should match other static elements
- Page links and page titles should use mixed case, unless a league or is the widely accepted style (MLB, MiLB, etc)
- Reduce the number of options for the user to make it easier to get to content
- Keep a consistent visual aesthetic across breakpoints
- Make sure elements are structured well within layout and interactive elements are styled in a manner to indicate interactivity. The page links should be styled individually and distinctively from other interactive elements.
- Have all options accessible to the user at all times. If hidden from initial view, make it clear to the user they can access it in some manner.
- The location and usage of this navigation should be universally accessible for clients that may have oddball main navigations. This navigation should stand alone on the page and not have additional elements included within it.
- Provide help and/or tips to allow the user to more quickly identify and understand the functionality of the element. Foundation's Joyride is a suggestion.
